A BILL

To provide for the establishment of a program by the National Science Foundation to support undergraduate science, technology, engineering, and mathematics education at Hispanic-serving institutions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Hispanic Opportunity
5 Program in Education and Science Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF PROGRAM.**

2 Not later than 120 days after the date of enactment
3 of this Act, the Director of the National Science Founda-
4 tion shall establish the program described in section 7033
5 of the America COMPETES Act (42 U.S.C. 1862o–12)
6 for Hispanic-serving institutions (as defined in section 502
7 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1101a)).

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
