A BILL

To extend the authority of the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture to carry out the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Lands Recre-
5 ation Enhancement Act Extension Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY UNDER FEDERAL**
7 **LANDS RECREATION ENHANCEMENT ACT.**

8 Section 810 of the Federal Lands Recreation En-
9 hancement Act (16 U.S.C. 6809) is amended to read as
10 follows:

11 **“SEC. 810. SUNSET PROVISION.**

12 “The authority of the Secretary to carry out this title
13 shall terminate on September 30, 2017.”.

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
