3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF EMPLOYER WAGE CREDIT FOR**
4 **EMPLOYEES WHO ARE ACTIVE DUTY MEM-**
5 **BERS OF THE UNIFORMED SERVICES.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (f) of section 45P of
7 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking
8 “December 31, 2014” and inserting “December 31,
9 2015”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section shall apply to payments made after December
3 31, 2014.
