A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide for an increase in the limit on the length of an agreement under the Medicare independence at home medical practice demonstration program.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Medicare Independence
5 at Home Medical Practice Demonstration Improvement
6 Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCREASE IN THE LIMIT ON THE LENGTH OF AN**
2 **AGREEMENT UNDER THE MEDICARE INDE-**
3 **PENDENCE AT HOME MEDICAL PRACTICE**
4 **DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM.**

5 Section 1866E(e)(1) of the Social Security Act (42
6 U.S.C. 1395cc–5(e)(1)) is amended by striking “3-year”
7 and inserting “5-year”.
