2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MINIMUM WAGE APPLICABLE TO AMERICAN**
4 **SAMOA.**

5 Section 8103(b)(2) of the Fair Minimum Wage Act
6 of 2007 (29 U.S.C. 206(b)(2) note) is amended—

7 (1) in subparagraph (A)—

1 (A) by striking “on the date of enactment
2 of this Act” and inserting “May 1, 2015”; and

3 (B) by inserting “and” after the semicolon;
4 and

5 (2) by striking subparagraphs (B) and (C) and
6 inserting the following:

7 “(B) increased thereafter by such amount
8 and at such time as determined by the govern-
9 ment of American Samoa.”.

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
