A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to discontinue funding for landscaping and scenic enhancement.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Roads Not Roses Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. LANDSCAPING AND SCENIC ENHANCEMENT FUND-**
6 **ING DISCONTINUED.**

7 (a) REPEAL.—Section 319 of title 23, United States
8 Code, is repealed.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Section 319 of title 23,
10 United States Code, as in effect the day before the date

1 of enactment of this Act, shall apply to landscape and
2 roadside development as part of a construction project of
3 Federal-aid highways if funds were obligated for the
4 project before such date of enactment.
