A BILL

To reauthorize the matching grant program for school security
in the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets
Act of 1968.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “School Safety Act of
5 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL SECU-**
2 **RITY.**

3 Part AA of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and
4 Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3797a et seq.) is
5 amended—

6 (1) in section 2701—

7 (A) in subsection (a), by striking “and
8 other deterrent measures” and inserting “,
9 other deterrent measures, and emergency notifi-
10 cation and response technologies”; and

11 (B) in subsection (b)—

12 (i) by redesignating paragraph (5) as
13 paragraph (6); and

14 (ii) by inserting after paragraph (4)
15 the following:

16 “(5) Acquisition and installation of technology
17 for expedited notification of local law enforcement
18 during an emergency.”; and

19 (2) in section 2705, by striking “fiscal years
20 2001 through 2009” and inserting “fiscal years
21 2016 through 2020”.

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
