A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to clarify the amount and duration of scholarships under the Department of Veterans Affairs Employee Incentive Scholarship Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Train Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DURATION AND AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS UNDER**
2 **DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS EM-**
3 **PLOYEE INCENTIVE SCHOLARSHIP PRO-**
4 **GRAM.**

5 (a) DURATION OF SCHOLARSHIP.—

6 (1) AGREEMENT.—Section 7672(e)(1)(A) of
7 title 38, United States Code, is amended by striking
8 “three” and inserting “four”.

9 (2) PERIOD OF PAYMENT.—Subsection (c)(2) of
10 section 7673 of such title is amended by striking
11 “three” and inserting “four”.

12 (b) AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP.—Subsection (b)(1) of
13 such section 7673 is amended by striking “\$10,000” and
14 inserting “\$25,000”.

15 (c) APPLICATION.—

16 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendments made by
17 this section shall apply with respect to individuals
18 who first enroll in the Department of Veterans Af-
19 fairs Employee Incentive Scholarship Program under
20 subchapter VI of chapter 76 of title 38, United
21 States Code, on or after the date of the enactment
22 of this Act.

23 (2) SPECIAL RULE FOR CURRENT PARTICI-
24 PANTS.—An individual who is enrolled in such pro-
25 gram as of the day before the date of the enactment
26 of this Act may elect to be covered by the amend-

1 ments made by this section with respect to a quar-
2 ter, semester, or term, as applicable, commencing on
3 or after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
