A BILL

To ensure a legislative solution for those individuals who may be affected by ObamaCare’s unlawful implementation, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Prevention of Bureau-
5 cratic Workarounds Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PREVENTING BUREAUCRATIC WORKAROUNDS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Health and
8 Human Services shall not enter into contract with a State,
9 or otherwise award any assistance to a State, to make
10 available to the State any technology that is used as part

1 of the Federal health insurance exchange established
2 under section 1321 of the Patient Protection and Afford-
3 able Care Act (42 U.S.C. 18041).

4 (b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in sub-
5 section (a) shall be construed to prohibit a State from es-
6 tablishing a State-based Exchange under section 1321 of
7 the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (42
8 U.S.C. 18041).

9 (c) APPLICABILITY.—This Act applies only with re-
10 spect to contracts entered into, and assistance awarded,
11 after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
