Mr. GROTHMAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To require that any revision to, or establishment of, a national primary or secondary ambient air quality standard be made by statute, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Manufacturers First
5 Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. REVISION TO, OR ESTABLISHMENT OF, NATIONAL**
2 **AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS BY STAT-**
3 **UTE ONLY.**

4 Except as provided by a Federal statute enacted after
5 the date of enactment of this Act—

6 (1) the national primary and secondary ambient
7 air quality standard for any air pollutant under sec-
8 tion 109 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7409), as
9 in effect on the date of enactment of this Act, shall
10 remain in effect; and

11 (2) notwithstanding any provision of the Clean
12 Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7401 et seq.), the Administrator
13 of the Environmental Protection Agency may not
14 issue, implement, or enforce—

15 (A) any revision to any such standard; or

16 (B) any new such standard.

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
