A BILL

To amend the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act to require the Secretary of Homeland Security to take appropriate actions to ensure that an alien who is unlawfully present in the United States, is in removal proceedings or has been ordered removed, and is required to register under the Act, is so registered, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Tracking Reoffending
5 Alien Criminals Act of 2015” or the “TRAC Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN ALIENS WHILE RE-**
2 **MOVAL PROCEEDINGS ARE PENDING.**

3 Subtitle A of the Sex Offender Registration and Noti-
4 fication Act (42 U.S.C. 16901 et seq.) is amended by add-
5 ing at the end the following:

6 **“SEC. 132. REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN ALIENS WHILE RE-**
7 **MOVAL PROCEEDINGS ARE PENDING.**

8 “The Secretary of Homeland Security shall take ap-
9 propriate actions to ensure that an alien is registered
10 under this Act if the Secretary determines that the alien—

11 “(1) is unlawfully present in the United States;

12 “(2) is in removal proceedings or has been or-
13 dered removed; and

14 “(3) is required to register under this Act.”.

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
