Mr. SIMPSON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain land in Blaine County, Idaho, to the city of Ketchum, Idaho, to be used to support recreation, educational, and public purposes, including river restoration, floodplain management, and municipal water storage, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF LAND TO KETCHUM, IDAHO.**

4 (a) DEFINITIONS.—For the purposes of this Act, the
5 following definitions shall apply:

1 (1) MAP.—The term “map” means the map ti-
2 tled “Ketchum R&PPA Proposal North & South
3 R&PP Parcels” and dated 2/2012.

4 (2) PROPERTY.—The term “Property” means
5 the total of approximately 374.5 acres of land in
6 Blaine County, Idaho, generally depicted on the map
7 as “North R&PP Parcel” and “South R&PP Par-
8 cel”.

9 (3) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
10 the Secretary of the Interior.

11 (b) CONVEYANCE.—As soon as practicable after the
12 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary, acting
13 through the Director of the Bureau of Land Management,
14 shall convey to the city of Ketchum, Idaho, subject to valid
15 existing rights, without consideration, all right, title, and
16 interest of the United States in and to the Property.

17 (c) MAP ON FILE.—The map shall be on file and
18 available for public inspection in the appropriate offices
19 of the Bureau of Land Management.

20 (d) USE OF CONVEYED LANDS.—

21 (1) PURPOSE.—The land conveyed under this
22 sections shall be used to support recreation, edu-
23 cational, and public purposes, including river res-
24 toration, floodplain management, and municipal
25 water storage.

1 (2) RESTRICTION.—The land conveyed under
2 this section shall not be used for residential or com-
3 mercial purposes except for public events and activi-
4 ties that are permitted by the City of Ketchum.

5 (3) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—
6 The Secretary of the Interior may require such addi-
7 tional terms and conditions in connection with the
8 conveyance as the Secretary considers appropriate to
9 protect the interests of the United States.

10 (e) REVERSION.—If the land conveyed under this sec-
11 tion is no longer used in accordance with subsection (d)
12 the land shall, at the discretion of the Secretary based on
13 the Secretary’s determination of the best interests of the
14 United States, revert to the United States.

15 (f) ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS.—The Secretary shall re-
16 quire that the city of Ketchum, Idaho, pay all survey costs
17 and other administrative costs necessary for the prepara-
18 tion and completion of any patents and transfer of title
19 under this section.

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
