3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Disabled Veterans Red
5 Tape Reduction Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. FIVE-YEAR EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY OF THE SEC-**
2 **RETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS TO PROVIDE**
3 **FOR THE CONDUCT OF MEDICAL DISABILITY**
4 **EXAMINATIONS BY CONTRACT PHYSICIANS.**

5 Section 704(c) of the Veterans Benefits Act of 2003
6 (Public Law 108–183; 38 U.S.C. 5101 note) is amended
7 by striking “December 31, 2015” and inserting “Decem-
8 ber 31, 2018”.
