A BILL

To provide for the issuance of a commemorative postage
stamp in honor of George Henry White.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. GEORGE HENRY WHITE COMMEMORATIVE**
2 **POSTAGE STAMP.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Postmaster General shall
4 issue a commemorative postage stamp in honor of George
5 Henry White.

6 (b) SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS.—Such stamp—

7 (1) shall be issued in the denomination used for
8 first class mail up to one ounce in weight;

9 (2) shall bear such designs as the Postmaster
10 General shall determine; and

11 (3) shall be placed on sale as soon as prac-
12 ticable after the date of the enactment of this Act
13 and shall be sold for such period thereafter as the
14 Postmaster General shall determine.

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
