3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Background Check
5 Completion Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF REQUIREMENT THAT A FIREARMS**
2 **DEALER TRANSFER A FIREARM IF THE NA-**
3 **TIONAL INSTANT CRIMINAL BACKGROUND**
4 **CHECK SYSTEM HAS BEEN UNABLE TO COM-**
5 **plete A BACKGROUND CHECK OF THE PRO-**
6 **SPECTIVE TRANSFEREE WITHIN 3 BUSINESS**
7 **DAYS.**
