Mr. CICILLINE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

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## A BILL

To amend title 39, United States Code, to provide that post offices shall comply with public accommodation standards under the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. POST OFFICES AND AMERICANS WITH DIS-**  
4       **ABILITY ACT STANDARDS.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 410(b) of title 39, United  
6       States Code, is amended—

7               (1) in paragraph (8), by inserting “consistent  
8       with paragraph (12),” before “the provisions”;

1           (2) in paragraph (10), by striking “and” at the  
2       end;

3           (3) in paragraph (11), by striking the period at  
4       the end and inserting “; and”; and

5           (4) by adding at the end the following:

6           “(12) with respect to any post office, the re-  
7       quirements of title III of the Americans with Dis-  
8       abilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.) as  
9       if such post office was a public accommodation  
10      under such title.”.

11       (b) APPLICATION.—The amendments made by sub-  
12      section (a) shall apply to any post office established before,  
13      on, or after the date of enactment of this Act.

14       (c) DEADLINE FOR COMPLIANCE.—Any post office  
15      covered by section 410(b)(12) of title 39, United States  
16      Code, as added by subsection (a), shall comply with the  
17      requirements of such section not later than the date that  
18      is 2 years after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
