A BILL

To direct the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration to initiate a rulemaking with respect to aircraft medical kits, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Airplane Kids In Tran-
5 sit Safety Act of 2015” or the “Airplane KITS Act of
6 2015”.

7 **SEC. 2. AIRCRAFT MEDICAL KITS.**

8 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
9 of this Act, the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Ad-

1 ministration shall initiate a rulemaking to ensure that the
2 medical kits required to be carried in aircraft operated by
3 air carriers contain appropriate medication and equipment
4 to meet the emergency medical needs of children, including
5 an epinephrine auto-injector.
