A BILL

To prohibit the Department of Health and Human Services from obligating or expending any funds for grants for developing or evaluating a video game to train parents in food parenting practices, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITING GRANT FUNDS FOR “KIDDIO:**
2 **FOOD FIGHT—TRAINING VEGETABLE PAR-**
3 **ENTING PRACTICES”.**

4 (a) PROHIBITION.—The Department of Health and
5 Human Services may not obligate or expend any funds
6 for—

7 (1) grant project # 4R44HD075521–02 of the
8 National Institutes of Health (“Kiddio: Food
9 Fight—Training Vegetable Parenting Practices”; or
10 (2) any other grant, contract, or cooperative
11 agreement for developing or evaluating a video game
12 to train parents in food parenting practices.

13 (b) UNOBLIGATED BALANCES.—Of the amounts
14 made available for any grant, contract, or cooperative
15 agreement of the Department of Health and Human Serv-
16 ices described in paragraph (1), the unobligated balances
17 of such amounts are hereby rescinded.

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
