A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to extend the authority of the Internal Revenue Service to require truncated social security numbers on Form W-2 wage and tax statements.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Taxpayer Identity Pro-
5 tection Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTEND INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE AUTHORITY**
2 **TO REQUIRE TRUNCATED SOCIAL SECURITY**
3 **NUMBERS ON FORM W-2.**

4 (a) WAGES.—Paragraph (2) of section 6051(a) of the
5 Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking
6 “his social security account number” and inserting “an
7 identifying number for the employee”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 this section shall take effect on the date of the enactment
10 of this Act.

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
