A BILL

To terminate the independent third-party program for sectors of the Northeast Multispecies Fishery unless the program is fully funded by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “New England Fisher-
5 men Preservation Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF INDEPENDENT THIRD-PARTY**
2 **MONITORING.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection
4 (b), the Secretary of Commerce shall not require sectors
5 of the Northeast Multispecies Fishery to comply with the
6 independent third-party monitoring program required by
7 section 648.87 of title 50, Code of Federal Regulations
8 (or similar successor regulation).

9 (b) EXCEPTION.—The Secretary of Commerce may
10 require sectors of the Northeast Multispecies Fishery to
11 comply with the independent third-party monitoring pro-
12 gram required by section 648.87 of title 50, Code of Fed-
13 eral Regulations (or similar successor regulation), if the
14 Administrator of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric
15 Administration fully funds the program with funds appro-
16 priated for the Administration.

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
