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## A BILL

To amend title 31, United States Code, to require an annual report from the Financial Management Service within the Department of the Treasury regarding amounts paid or payable by Federal agencies to the judgement fund, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Judgement Fund Tax-  
5       payer Accountability Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORT FROM THE FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT**  
2 **SERVICE.**

3 Section 1304 of title 31, United States Code, is  
4 amended by adding at the end the following:

5 “(d) Not later than January 1 of each year, the Fi-  
6 nancial Management Service shall report to Congress the  
7 following information with regard to each agency (as de-  
8 fined in section 551 of title 5) on account of payments  
9 made from sums appropriated by this section:

10 “(1) The total amount paid in reimbursement  
11 by that agency during the preceding fiscal year on  
12 account of each such payment.

13 “(2) The total amount still due from that agen-  
14 cy in reimbursement for each such payment, as of  
15 the end of the preceding fiscal year.

16 “(3) For each of the amounts described in  
17 paragraph (1) or (2), the name of the plaintiff or  
18 claimant to whom the payment was made from sums  
19 so appropriated.”.

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
