3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Investing in 21st Cen-
5 tury Schools Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION AND MODIFICATION OF QUALIFIED**
2 **ZONE ACADEMY BONDS.**

3 (a) EXTENSION.—Section 54E(c)(1) of the Internal
4 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking “and 2014”
5 and inserting “2014, 2015, and 2016”.

6 (b) REDUCTION OF PRIVATE BUSINESS CONTRIBU-
7 TION REQUIREMENT.—Section 54E(b) of such Code is
8 amended by striking “10 percent” and inserting “5 per-
9 cent”.

10 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
11 this section shall apply to obligations issued after the date
12 of the enactment of this Act.

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
