AN ACT

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a special resource study of Chicano Park, located in San Diego, California, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Chicano Park Preser-
3 vation Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. SPECIAL RESOURCE STUDY.**

5 (a) STUDY.—The Secretary of the Interior shall con-
6 duct a special resource study of Chicano Park and its mu-
7 rals located in San Diego, California.

8 (b) CONTENTS.—In conducting the study under sub-
9 section (a), the Secretary shall—

10 (1) evaluate the national significance of the
11 site;

12 (2) determine the suitability and feasibility of
13 designating the site as a National Historic Land-
14 mark or Affiliated Area of the National Park Sys-
15 tem;

16 (3) consider other alternatives for preservation,
17 protection, and interpretation of Chicano Park and
18 its murals by Federal, State, or local governmental
19 entities, or private and nonprofit organizations;

20 (4) consult with interested Federal, State, or
21 local governmental entities, private and nonprofit or-
22 ganizations or any other interested individuals; and

23 (5) identify cost estimates for any development,
24 interpretation, operation, and maintenance associ-
25 ated with the alternatives.

1 (c) APPLICABLE LAW.—The study required under
2 subsection (a) shall be conducted in accordance with sec-
3 tion 100507 of title 54, United States Code, except that
4 the study shall not consider any options that involve Fed-
5 eral acquisition of lands, interests in lands, or any other
6 property related to the Chicano Park and its murals.

7 (d) REPORT.—Not later than 18 months after the
8 date on which funds are first made available for the study
9 under subsection (a), the Secretary shall submit to the
10 Committee on Natural Resources of the House of Rep-
11 resentatives and the Committee on Energy and Natural
12 Resources of the Senate a report containing the results
13 of the study and any conclusions and recommendations of
14 the Secretary.
