A BILL

To prohibit United States contributions to the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change, the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, and the Green Climate Fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Tax Dollars for
5 the United Nations’ Climate Agenda Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON UNITED STATES CONTRIBUTIONS**
2 **TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL PANEL ON**
3 **CLIMATE CHANGE, THE UNITED NATIONS**
4 **FRAMEWORK CONVENTION ON CLIMATE**
5 **CHANGE, AND THE GREEN CLIMATE FUND.**

6 (a) PROHIBITION.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
7 sion of law, no funds made available to any Federal de-
8 partment or agency may be used to make assessed or vol-
9 untary contributions on behalf of the United States to or
10 for the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change
11 (IPCC), the United Nations Framework Convention on
12 Climate Change (UNFCCC), or the Green Climate Fund.

13 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The prohibition on use of
14 funds contained in subsection (a) applies with respect to
15 funds made available for fiscal year 2016 and subsequent
16 fiscal years.

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
