3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Assuring Law Enforce-
5 ment Requests Are Timely Evaluated by the Department

1 of Homeland Security Act of 2015” or the “ALERTED
2 Act of 2015”.

3 **SEC. 2. DETERMINATION OF ISSUANCE OF DETAINER.**

4 Section 287(d) of the Immigration and Nationality
5 Act (8 U.S.C. 1357(d)) is amended in the matter pre-
6 ceding paragraph (1), by striking “relating to controlled
7 substances”.

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
