A BILL

To increase the penalties for fentanyl trafficking.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Trafficking in
5 Fentanyl Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. ENHANCED PENALTIES.**

7 Section 401(b)(1) of the Controlled Substances Act
8 (21 U.S.C. 841(b)(1)) is amended—

9 (1) in subparagraph (A)(vi)—

1 (A) by striking “400 grams” and inserting
2 “20 grams”; and
3 (B) by striking “100 grams” and inserting
4 “5 grams”; and
5 (2) in subparagraph (B)(vi)—
6 (A) by striking “40 grams” and inserting
7 “2 grams”; and
8 (B) by striking “10 grams” and inserting
9 “0.5 grams”.

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
