Ms. JUDY CHU of California (for herself and Mr. KELLY of Mississippi) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Small Business

A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to modify determinations of the total value of contract awards.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Transparency in Small
5 Business Goaling Act of 2016”.

6 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION TO DETERMINATIONS OF THE**
7 **TOTAL VALUE OF CONTRACT AWARDS.**

8 Section 15(g) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
9 644(g)) is amended by adding at the end the following
10 new paragraph:

1 “(4) DETERMINATIONS OF THE TOTAL VALUE
2 OF CONTRACT AWARDS.—For purposes of the goals
3 established under paragraphs (1) and (2), the total
4 value of contract awards for a fiscal year may not
5 be determined in a manner that excludes the value
6 of a contract based on—

7 “(A) where the contract is awarded;

8 “(B) where the contract is performed;

9 “(C) whether the contract is mandated by
10 Federal law to be performed by an entity other
11 than a small business concern;

12 “(D) whether funding for the contract is
13 made available in an appropriations Act, if the
14 contract is subject to the requirements of chap-
15 ter 33 of title 41, United States Code, or chap-
16 ter 137 of title 10, United States Code, and the
17 Federal Acquisition Regulation; or

18 “(E) whether the contract is otherwise
19 subject to the Federal Acquisition Regulation.”.

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
