A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to provide a five-year extension of the special survivor indemnity allowance provided to widows and widowers of deceased members of the uniformed services affected by required Survivor Benefit Plan annuity offset for dependency and indemnity compensation received under section 1311(a) of title 38, United States Code.

1 **SECTION 1. FIVE-YEAR EXTENSION OF SPECIAL SURVIVOR**
2 **INDEMNITY ALLOWANCE FOR WIDOWS AND**
3 **WIDOWERS OF DECEASED MEMBERS OF THE**
4 **UNIFORMED SERVICES AFFECTED BY RE-**
5 **QUIRED SURVIVOR BENEFIT PLAN ANNUITY**
6 **OFFSET FOR DEPENDENCY AND INDEMNITY**
7 **COMPENSATION.**

8 Section 1450(m)(2) of title 10, United States Code,
9 is amended—

- 10 (1) in subparagraph (H) by striking “and”;
11 (2) in subparagraph (I) by striking the period
12 after “\$310” and inserting a semicolon; and
13 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
14 paragraphs:
15 “(J) for months during fiscal year 2018,
16 \$400;
17 “(K) for months during fiscal year 2019,
18 \$475;
19 “(L) for months during fiscal year 2020,
20 \$600;
21 “(M) for months during fiscal year 2021,
22 \$700; and
23 “(N) for months during fiscal year 2022,
24 \$800.”.

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
