Mr. CARTER of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to authorize COPS grantees to use grant funds for active shooter training, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “POLICE Act of 2016”.

5 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL AUTHORIZED USE OF COPS FUNDS.**

6 Section 1701(b) of the Omnibus Crime Control and
7 Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796dd(b)) is amend-
8 ed—

1 (1) in paragraph (16), by striking “; and” at
2 the end;

3 (2) in paragraph (17), by striking the period at
4 the end and inserting “; and”; and

5 (3) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(18) to participate in nationally-recognized ac-
7 tive shooter training programs that offer scenario-
8 based, integrated response courses designed to
9 counter active shooter threats or acts of terrorism
10 against individuals or facilities.”.

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
