A BILL

To forbid Federal agencies from buying Apple products until Apple provides the Federal Government with technical support necessary to access encrypted information sought by a warrant that may be materially relevant to the commission of terrorism.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Taxpayer Support
5 for Apple Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON PURCHASE.**

2 No agency or other entity within the executive, legis-
3 lative, or judicial branch of the Federal Government may
4 purchase any product manufactured by, licensed by, or
5 otherwise sold under the trademark of Apple Inc. of 1 Infi-
6 nite Loop, Cupertino, California (hereafter referred to
7 “Apple”) until a court of Federal jurisdiction certifies that
8 Apple has provided the Federal Government with the tech-
9 nical support necessary to access encrypted information
10 sought by a judicial warrant that may be materially rel-
11 evant to the investigation of commission of terrorism.
