3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Adoption Leave for
5 Military Families Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REVISION IN DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE POLICIES**
7 **REGARDING ADOPTIVE LEAVE FOR DUAL**
8 **MILITARY COUPLES.**

9 Section 701(i)(3) of title 10, United States Code, is
10 amended by striking “only one such member shall be al-

1 lowed leave under this subsection” and inserting “one of
2 the members is allowed up to 21 days of leave under this
3 subsection and the other member may be allowed up to
4 14 days of leave under this subsection”.

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
