A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to clarify the eligibility for monthly stipends paid under the Post-9/11 Educational Assistance Program for certain members of the reserve components of the Armed Forces.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. MONTHLY STIPEND FOR CERTAIN MEMBERS**
2 **OF THE RESERVE COMPONENTS OF THE**
3 **ARMED FORCES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 3313 of title 38, United
5 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
6 lowing new subsection:

7 “(j) DETERMINATION OF MONTHLY STIPENDS DUR-
8 ING CERTAIN ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE.—

9 “(1) PRO RATA BASIS.—In any month in which
10 an individual described in paragraph (2) is per-
11 forming active duty service described in section
12 3301(1)(B) of this title, the Secretary shall deter-
13 mine the amount of monthly stipends payable under
14 this section for such month on a pro rata basis for
15 the period of such month in which the covered indi-
16 vidual is not performing such active duty service.

17 “(2) INDIVIDUAL DESCRIBED.—An individual
18 described in this paragraph is an individual who is—

19 “(A) a member of the reserve components
20 of the Armed Forces; and

21 “(B) pursuing a program of education
22 using educational assistance under this chap-
23 ter.”.

24 (b) APPLICATION.—The amendment made by sub-
25 section (a) shall apply with respect to a quarter, semester,

1 or term, as applicable, commencing on or after August 1,
2 2016.
