A BILL

To remove the Federal claim to navigational servitude for a tract of land developed due to dredging disposal from a harbor project in Valdez, Alaska, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. VALDEZ, ALASKA.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to subsection (b), the por-
5 tion of the project for navigation, Valdez, Alaska, identi-
6 fied as Tract G, Harbor Subdivision, shall not be subject
7 to navigational servitude beginning on the date of enact-
8 ment of this Act.

1 (b) ENTRY BY FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.—The Fed-
2 eral Government may enter upon the property referred to
3 in subsection (a) to carry out any required operation and
4 maintenance of the general navigation features of the
5 project referred to in subsection (a).
