A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to reform the HUBZone
program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Growing And Reviving
5 Rural Economies Through Transitioning HUBZone Re-
6 designation Act of 2016”.

7 **SEC. 2. HUBZONE REFORMS.**

8 (a) REDESIGNATED AREAS.—Section 3(p) of the
9 Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 632(p)) is amended in
10 paragraph (4)(C), by striking “until the later of” and all

1 that follows and inserting “for the 7-year period following
2 the date on which the census tract or nonmetropolitan
3 county ceased to be so qualified.”.

4 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub-
5 section (a) shall apply to any census tract or nonmetro-
6 politan county that is a redesignated area or becomes a
7 redesignated area under section 3(p)(4)(C) of the Small
8 Business Act (15 U.S.C. 632(p)(4)(C)) on or after the
9 date of enactment of this Act.

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
