A BILL

To require the Attorney General to review foreign forms of identification, including consular identification cards and foreign passports without a valid visa, to establish a valid and secure form of identification, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Foreign ID Review
5 Act of 2016”.

1 **SEC. 2. REVIEW OF FOREIGN IDENTIFICATION.**

2 The Attorney General shall, not later than 270 days
3 after the date of enactment of this Act, and every 2 years
4 thereafter, review all forms of identification issued to for-
5 eign nationals within the United States by the Govern-
6 ments of Mexico, Nicaragua, El Salvador, Guatemala, and
7 Honduras, including identifications issued by consular of-
8 ficers and foreign passports issued at consular offices, to
9 determine if such forms of identification are sufficiently
10 secure to verify the identity of the bearer of the form of
11 identification for purposes including opening an account
12 with an accredited financial institution and obtaining any
13 benefit that the child of such bearer is lawfully entitled
14 to.

15 **SEC. 3. REPORT TO CONGRESS.**

16 Not later than 90 days after the completion of the
17 review under section 2, the Attorney General shall submit
18 to the Committee on the Judiciary of the House of Rep-
19 resentatives and the Committee on the Judiciary of the
20 Senate a report that includes the results of such review.

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
