To require the Director of the Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection to verify the accuracy of consumer complaint information before making such information available to the public.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT TO VERIFY INFORMATION IN**
4 **THE COMPLAINT DATABASE BEFORE IT MAY**
5 **BE RELEASED TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.**

6 Section 1013(b)(3)(A) of the Consumer Financial
7 Protection Act of 2010 (12 U.S.C. 5493(b)(3)(A)) is
8 amended by adding at the end the following: “The Direc-

1 tor may not make any information about a consumer com-
2 plaint in such database available to the public without first
3 verifying the accuracy of all facts alleged in such com-
4 plaint.”.
