A BILL

To require advance appropriations for the expenditure of
any funds collected by the Environmental Protection Agency.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “End EPA Rogue
5 Spending Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EPA COLLECTIONS SUBJECT TO APPROPRIATIONS.**

7 Any fees collected by the Environmental Protection
8 Agency through fines, fees, penalties, settlement agree-

1 ments, or otherwise shall, notwithstanding any other pro-
2 vision of law, be deposited in the general fund of the
3 Treasury and may be expended by the Environmental Pro-
4 tection Agency only to the extent provided in advance by
5 an appropriations Act.
