A BILL

To amend the Controlled Substances Act to add certain synthetic substances to schedule I, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Dangerous Synthetic
5 Drug Control Act of 2016”.

1 **SEC. 2. TREATMENT OF CERTAIN DESIGNER DRUGS AS**
 2 **SCHEDULE I CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.**

3 (a) CANNABIMIMETIC AGENTS.—Schedule I, as set
 4 forth in section 202(c) of the Controlled Substances Act
 5 (21 U.S.C. 812(c)), is amended in subsection (d)(2)(B)—

6 (1) in clause (xiv) by striking “and” at the end;

7 (2) in clause (xv) by striking the period and in-
 8 serting a semicolon; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(xvi) 2-(2-methylphenyl)-1-(1-pentyl-
 11 1H-indol-3-yl)ethanone (JWH–251);

12 “(xvii) (1-butyl-1H-indol-3-yl)(4-
 13 methylnaphthalen-1-yl)methanone (4’-

15 “(xviii) 2-(3-methoxyphenyl)-1-(1-
 16 pentyl-1H-indol-3-yl)ethanone (JWH–302);

14 (b) SYNTHETIC OPIOIDS.—Schedule I, as set forth in
 15 section 202(c) of the Controlled Substances Act (21
 16 U.S.C. 812(c)), is amended in subsection (a) by adding
 17 at the end the following:

18 “(43) Butyryl fentanyl.

19 “(44) beta-Hydroxythiofentanyl.

20 “(45) Acetyl fentanyl.”.

21 (c) OTHER DRUGS.—Schedule I, as set forth in sec-
 22 tion 202(c) of the Controlled Substances Act (21 U.S.C.
 23 812(c)), is amended in subsection (c) by adding at the
 24 end the following:

1 “(29) 1-(naphthalen-1-yl)-2-(pyrrolidin-1-
2 yl)pentan-1-one (α -naphyrone).

3 “(30) 1-(2,3-dihydrobenzofuran-5-yl)propan-2-
4 amine (5-APDB).

5 “(31) 1-(2,3-dihydrobenzofuran-6-yl)propan-2-
6 amine (6-APDB).

7 “(32) 6,7-dihydro-5H-indeno[5,6-d][1,3]dioxol-
8 6-amine (MDAI).

9 “(33) 5-iodo-2,3-dihydro-1H-inden-2-amine (5-
10 IAI).

11 “(34) 1-(4-bromofuro[2,3-f]benzofuran-8-
12 yl)propan-2-amine (bromo-dragonfly).

13 “(35) 1-(4-chloro-2,5-dimethoxyphenyl)propan-
14 2-amine (DOC).

15 “(36) 1-(4-ethoxy-2,5-dimethoxyphenyl)propan-
16 2-amine (MEM).”.

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
