Mr. WELCH (for himself and Mr. CRAMER) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to revise the amount of minimum allotments under the Projects for Assistance in Transition from Homelessness Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “PATH Fairness Act
5 of 2016”.

1 **SEC. 2. MINIMUM ALLOTMENTS UNDER THE PROJECTS**
2 **FOR ASSISTANCE IN TRANSITION FROM**
3 **HOMELESSNESS PROGRAM.**

4 Section 524 of the Public Health Service Act (42
5 U.S.C. 290cc-24) is amended to read as follows:

6 **“SEC. 524. DETERMINATION OF AMOUNT OF ALLOTMENT.**

7 “(a) DETERMINATION UNDER FORMULA.—Subject
8 to subsection (b), the allotment required in section 521
9 for a State for a fiscal year is the product of—

10 “(1) an amount equal to the amount appro-
11 priated under section 535 for the fiscal year; and

12 “(2) a percentage equal to the quotient of—

13 “(A) an amount equal to the population
14 living in urbanized areas of the State involved,
15 as indicated by the most recent data collected
16 by the Bureau of the Census; and

17 “(B) an amount equal to the population
18 living in urbanized areas of the United States,
19 as indicated by the sum of the respective
20 amounts determined for the States under sub-
21 paragraph (A).

22 “(b) MINIMUM ALLOTMENT.—

23 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to paragraph (2),
24 the allotment for a State under section 521 for a fis-
25 cal year shall, at a minimum, be the greater of—

1 “(A) the amount the State received under
2 section 521 in fiscal year 2015; and

3 “(B) \$750,000 for each of the several
4 States, the District of Columbia, and the Com-
5 monwealth of Puerto Rico, and \$100,000 for
6 each of Guam, the Virgin Islands, American
7 Samoa, and the Commonwealth of the Northern
8 Mariana Islands.

9 “(2) CONDITION.—If the funds appropriated in
10 any fiscal year under section 535 are insufficient to
11 ensure that States receive a minimum allotment in
12 accordance with paragraph (1), then—

13 “(A) no State shall receive less than the
14 amount they received in fiscal year 2015; and

15 “(B) any funds remaining after amounts
16 are provided under subparagraph (A) shall be
17 used to meet the requirement of paragraph
18 (1)(B), to the maximum extent possible.”.

19 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

20 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (a) of section 535 of
21 the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 290cc–35) is
22 amended by striking “\$75,000,000 for each of the fiscal
23 years 2001 through 2003” and inserting “\$150,000,000
24 for each of fiscal years 2017 through 2021”.

1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 521 of the
2 Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 290cc–21) is amend-
3 ed by striking “fiscal years 1991 through 1994” and in-
4 serting “fiscal years 2017 through 2021”.

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
