Mr. POE of Texas (for himself, Mr. CARTER of Texas, Mr. FARENTHOLD, Mr. JONES, Mr. NUGENT, and Mr. RODNEY DAVIS of Illinois) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce

A BILL

To prohibit certain nutrition rules with respect to foods
sold at schools as a fundraiser.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bringing Awareness
5 and Knowledge to Exempt Schools Against Legislative
6 Encroachment Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN RULES.**

8 The Secretary of Agriculture shall not implement, ad-
9 minister, or enforce the rule entitled “National School

1 Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program: Nutrition
2 Standards for All Foods Sold in School as Required by
3 the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010” published
4 by the Department of Agriculture in the Federal Register
5 on June 28, 2013 (78 Fed. Reg. 39068 et seq.), with re-
6 spect to food sold as a fundraiser that takes place on the
7 grounds of a school, including any requirements with re-
8 spect to limiting the number of such fundraisers by State
9 agencies or the Secretary of Agriculture.

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
