2 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

3 This resolution may be cited as the “Strengthen
4 House Floor Integrity Resolution”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITING FORMER HOUSE OFFICIALS WITH**
2 **BUSINESS BEFORE CONGRESS FROM ADMIS-**
3 **SION TO HALL OF THE HOUSE FOR CEREMO-**
4 **NIAL OR EDUCATIONAL FUNCTIONS.**

5 Clause 4(b) of rule IV of the Rules of the House of
6 Representatives is amended to read as follows:

7 “(b) The Speaker may promulgate regulations to
8 carry out this rule, except that such regulations may not
9 exempt ceremonial or educational functions from the re-
10 strictions of this clause.”.
