Mrs. FEINSTEIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Jorge Rojas Gutierrez and Oliva Gonzalez Gonzalez.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR JORGE**
4 **ROJAS GUTIERREZ AND OLIVA GONZALEZ**
5 **GONZALEZ.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
7 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
8 Act (8 U.S.C. 1151), Jorge Rojas Gutierrez and Oliva
9 Gonzalez Gonzalez shall each be eligible for the issuance
10 of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status to that
11 of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence

1 upon filing an application for issuance of an immigrant
2 visa under section 204 of such Act (8 U.S.C. 1154) or
3 for adjustment of status to lawful permanent resident.

4 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Jorge Rojas
5 Gutierrez or Oliva Gonzalez Gonzalez enters the United
6 States before the filing deadline specified in subsection (c),
7 Jorge Rojas Gutierrez or Oliva Gonzalez Gonzalez, as ap-
8 propriate, shall be considered to have entered and re-
9 mained lawfully in the United States and shall be eligible
10 for adjustment of status under section 245 of the Immi-
11 gration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1255) as of the date
12 of the enactment of this Act.

13 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
14 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
15 plication for the issuance of an immigrant visa or the ap-
16 plication for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate
17 fees not later than 2 years after the date of the enactment
18 of this Act.

19 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBERS.—
20 Upon granting an immigrant visa or permanent residence
21 to Jorge Rojas Gutierrez and Oliva Gonzalez Gonzalez, the
22 Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer to re-
23 duce by 2, during the current or subsequent fiscal year,
24 the total number of immigrant visas that are made avail-
25 able to natives of the country of birth of Jorge Rojas

1 Gutierrez and Oliva Gonzalez Gonzalez under section
2 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
3 1153(a)) or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant
4 visas that are made available to natives of the country of
5 birth of Jorge Rojas Gutierrez and Oliva Gonzalez Gon-
6 zalez under section 202(e) of such Act (8 U.S.C. 1152(e)).

7 (e) PAYGO.—The budgetary effects of this Act, for
8 the purpose of complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-
9 Go Act of 2010, shall be determined by reference to the
10 latest statement titled “Budgetary Effects of PAYGO
11 Legislation” for this Act, submitted for printing in the
12 Congressional Record by the Chairman of the Senate
13 Budget Committee, provided that such statement has been
14 submitted prior to the vote on passage.
