A BILL

To reinstate certain mining claims in the State of Alaska.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SMALL MINER CLAIMS.**

4 (a) DEFINITION OF COVERED CLAIMHOLDER.—The
5 term “covered claimholder” means each of—

6 (1) the claimholder of claims in the State of
7 Alaska numbered AA023149, AA023163, AA47913,
8 AA047914, AA047915, AA047916, AA047917,
9 AA047918, and AA047919 (as of December 29,
10 2004); and

1 (2) the claimholder of the claim in the State of
2 Alaska numbered ADL: FF-0593215 (as of Decem-
3 ber 29, 2004).

4 (b) REINSTATMENT; OPPORTUNITY TO CURE DE-
5 FECTS.—The covered claimholders shall—

6 (1) be considered to qualify for relief under
7 paragraph (3) of section 10101(d) of the Omnibus
8 Budget Reconciliation Act of 1993 (30 U.S.C.
9 28f(d)); and

10 (2) have the opportunity under that paragraph
11 to cure defects with respect to the applicable claim
12 for any prior period during which—

13 (A) 1 or more defects existed; or

14 (B) there was a failure to pay claim main-
15 tenance fees.

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
