A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to authorize the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to adjudicate and pay survivor's benefits without requiring the filing of a formal claim, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Veterans’ Survivors
5 Claims Processing Automation Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXPEDITED PAYMENT OF SURVIVOR’S BENEFITS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5101(a)(1) of title 38,
8 United States Code, is amended—

1 (1) by striking “A specific” and inserting “(A)
 2 Except as provided in subparagraph (B), a specific”;
 3 and

4 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
 5 paragraph:

6 “(B)(i) The Secretary may pay benefits under chap-
 7 ters 13 and 15 and sections 2302, 2307, and 5121 of this
 8 title to a survivor of a veteran who has not filed a formal
 9 claim if the Secretary determines that the record contains
 10 sufficient evidence to establish the entitlement of the sur-
 11 vivor to such benefits.

12 “(ii) For purposes of this subparagraph and section
 13 5110 of this title, the date on which a survivor of a veteran
 14 notifies the Secretary of the death of the veteran shall be
 15 treated as the date of the receipt of the survivor’s applica-
 16 tion for benefits described in clause (i).”.

17 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 18 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to claims for bene-
 19 fits based on a death occurring on or after the date of
 20 the enactment of this Act.

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
