A BILL

To renew certain Moving to Work agreements for a period
of 10 years.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Keeping Moving to
5 Work Promises Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. RENEWAL OF MOVING TO WORK AGREEMENTS.**

7 (a) DEFINITION.—In this section—

8 (1) the term “covered agreement” means a
9 Moving to Work demonstration program agreement
10 between a public housing agency and the Secretary

1 pursuant to section 204 of the Departments of Vet-
2 erans Affairs and Housing and Urban Development,
3 and Independent Agencies Appropriations Act, 1996
4 (42 U.S.C. 1437f note) that—

5 (A) provides for the use of an alternative
6 operating fund formula; and

7 (B) is in effect on the date of enactment
8 of this Act; and

9 (2) the term “Secretary” means the Secretary
10 of Housing and Urban Development.

11 (b) RENEWAL OF AGREEMENTS.—

12 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall renew
13 each covered agreement for a period of 10 years.

14 (2) PROHIBITION ON CHANGES TO FINANCIAL
15 TERMS.—In renewing a covered agreement under
16 paragraph (1), the Secretary may not make any sig-
17 nificant change to the financial terms of the covered
18 agreement.

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
