A BILL

To preserve the current amount of basic allowance for housing for certain married members of the uniformed services.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PRESERVATION OF CURRENT BASIC ALLOW-**
4 **ANCE FOR HOUSING FOR CERTAIN MARRIED**
5 **MEMBERS OF THE UNIFORMED SERVICES.**

6 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the
7 amount of basic allowance for housing payable under sec-
8 tion 403 of title 37, United States Code, as of September
9 30, 2015, to a member of the uniformed services who is

1 married to another member of the uniformed services shall
2 not be reduced unless—

3 (1) the member and the member's spouse un-
4 dergo a permanent change of station requiring a
5 change of residence; or

6 (2) the member and the member's spouse move
7 into or commence living in on-base housing.

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
