A BILL

To reauthorize the National Forest Foundation Act, and
for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Forest Foun-
5 dation Reauthorization Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL FOREST FOUNDATION ACT REAUTHOR-**
7 **IZATION.**

8 (a) EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE MATCH-
9 ING FUNDS FOR ADMINISTRATIVE AND PROJECT EX-
10 PENSES.—Section 405(b) of the National Forest Founda-
11 tion Act (16 U.S.C. 583j–3(b)) is amended by striking

1 “for a period of five years beginning October 1, 1992”
 2 and inserting “for each of fiscal years 2016 through
 3 2018”.

4 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
 5 410(b) of the National Forest Foundation Act (16 U.S.C.
 6 583j–8(b)) is amended by striking “during the five-year
 7 period” and all that follows through “\$1,000,000 annu-
 8 ally” and inserting “there are authorized to be appro-
 9 priated \$3,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2016 through
 10 2018”.

11 (c) TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.—

12 (1) AGENT.—Section 404(b) of the National
 13 Forest Foundation Act (16 U.S.C. 583j–2(b)) is
 14 amended by striking “by this paragraph” and insert-
 15 ing “by subsection (a)(4)”.

16 (2) ANNUAL REPORT.—Section 407(b) of the
 17 National Forest Foundation Act (16 U.S.C. 583j–
 18 5(b)) is amended by striking the comma after “The
 19 Foundation shall”.

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
