5 6311(h)(1)(C)(i)) is amended by inserting “disability cat-
6 egory as described in subparagraphs (A)(i) and (if applica-
7 ble for the State) (B)(i) of section 602(3) of the Individ-
8 uals with Disabilities Education Act,” after “disability
9 status,”.

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
