A BILL

To modify the definition of “antique firearm”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO TITLE 18, UNITED STATES**
4 **CODE.**

5 Section 921(a)(16)(A) of title 18, United States
6 Code, is amended by striking “1898” and inserting “the
7 calendar year that is 100 years before the calendar year
8 in which the determination as to whether the firearm
9 meets the requirement of this subparagraph is being
10 made”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF**
2 **1986.**

3 Subsection (g) of section 5845 of the Internal Rev-
4 enue Code of 1986 is amended—

5 (1) by striking “1898” the first place it appears
6 and inserting “the calendar year that is 100 years
7 before the calendar year in which the determination
8 as to whether the firearm meets the requirement of
9 this subsection is being made”;

10 (2) by striking “the year 1898” and inserting
11 “the calendar year that is 100 years before the cal-
12 endar year in which such determination is being
13 made”; and

14 (3) by striking “1898,” and inserting “the cal-
15 endar year that is 100 years before the calendar
16 year in which such determination is being made,”.

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
