A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to make permanent the temporary increase in number of judges presiding over the United States Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Veterans Court of Ap-
5 peals Support Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. MAKING PERMANENT THE TEMPORARY INCREASE**
2 **IN NUMBER OF JUDGES PRESIDING OVER**
3 **COURT OF APPEALS FOR VETERANS CLAIMS.**

4 (a) PERMANENT INCREASE.—Subsection (a) of sec-
5 tion 7253 of title 38, United States Code, is amended by
6 striking “seven” and inserting “nine”.

7 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Such section is
8 further amended—

- 9 (1) in subsection (h), by striking paragraph (5);
10 and
11 (2) by striking subsection (i).

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
